**RULES:** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules

**TARGETS:** NRA Official Targets, A-23 **SQUADDING:** Will be assigned by the Statistical Office.

SCORE CARDS: SR-1 score cards will be used and MUST BE SIGNED BY THE COMPETITOR. If no classification is circled, a competitor or team will be placed in the Master Class.

CATEGORIES: Categories recognized: Open, Senior, Collegiate, Junior (includes Jr, IJ & SJ)

**CLASSIFICATION:** Each competitor will be placed in one class according to the NRA Classification System and shall be prepared to exhibit his classification card or Temporary Score Record Book. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master Class if they do not have an assigned classification.

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made.

**ENTRIES:** Entries are limited to 14 competitors which is the capacity of the range within the allotted time. Persons making entries within the time limit which cannot be accepted will be notified and their fees will be returned. Individual match entries must be received no later than Tuesday September 7, 2021. Post entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range, provided such entries will not require extra relays. . A post entry fee of \$5.00 will be assessed to all post entries. Email or call J. Michael O'Connor to request squadding.

SIGHTING SHOTS: Unlimited sighting shots will be allowed in all matches and must be taken within the time limit.

## MATCH SCHEDULE: 2 stages per match.

MATCH 1: Prone – 40 shots, any sights, 1 minute per shot, 20 minutes per stage MATCH 2: Standing – 40 shots, any sights,  $1^{1}/_{2}$  minutes per shot, 30 minutes per stage MATCH 3: Kneeling – 40 shots, any sights,  $1^{1}/_{2}$  minutes per shot, 30 minutes per stage

An individual winning a place award will not be entitled to a class or category award in the same match. Such class awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual.

State Championship Awards

The highest scoring Michigan resident will be named the Michigan 3-Position Outdoor Champion.

The highest scoring Michigan resident for each category (with a minimum of 3 competitors in that category) will receive an award for recognition as the Michigan Category Champion.
