Range Setup: August 11, 2023 @ 0700 hrs. **NO PRACTICE!**

Firing Times: Firing starts when ready.

Entries: **ON LINE ENTRIES ONLY WILL BE ACCEPTED.** A paid registration will be required to reserve a spot for a match. Entries will be accepted to the limit of the range. Cancellation Policy: Notice of cancellation made to the Match Director seven (7) days prior to the initial match date will be refunded 90% of the entry fee. Cancellations made within seven (7) days of the initial date of an event, including "NO SHOWS" the day of the event will not be refunded their match entry fee.

Fees: Team match will be at a cost of \$20.00 per person payable at the range the day of the match. Juniors with any NRA classification card shoot free - no awards.

Eligibility: Competitors must complete a MRPA-LR Release of Liability yearly. They must additionally be a member of the Michigan Rifle and Pistol Assn., their home state association, or pay a \$10 fee. NRA membership is not required. For MRPA memberships, see <http://www.michrpa.org>.

Pit Duty/ Pullers/ Other Duties: Electronic targets will be used; scoring duty will be required.

Rules: This is an NRA Approved match. Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules govern. All matches will be fired on the standard LR targets using Rule 5.6, prone position. The Match Director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and pit rotation based on number of competitors, weather, and range conditions.

Shooter Classification: The NRA Long Range classification system applies. Shooters must declare their Shooter Classification and Rifle division/class on each completed scorecard. Unclassified competitors compete in the Master Class or use their High-Power classification. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification apply.

Rifle Divisions: There will be four (4) rifle divisions: F-TR Rifle, F-Open Rifle, LR Rifle-Palma, and LR Rifle-Any-Any.

Teams: There will be four-member teams. Per Rule 2.10, Pick-up teams are authorized. All shooters on a team must be in the same Rifle Division.

Course of Fire Friday: For LR Rifle: Iron sights for LR. All others use Any Sights.

Match 1 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, slow-fire, 1000 yards; 63 minutes for two shooters.

Match 2 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, slow-fire, 1000 yards; 63 minutes for two shooters.

Match 3 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, slow-fire, 1000 yards; 63 minutes for two shooters.

Match 4 - Aggregate of all scores fired in matches 1-3.

Awards Disposition: MICHIGAN STATE LONG RANGE TEAM CHAMPIONS: The four-member team winners of each Rifle Division will be declared Michigan State Long Range Team Champions 2023.
